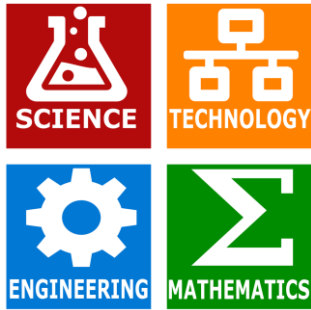

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MAKING PLANS FOR LIFE AFTER HIGH SCHOOL

CHOICES AFTER GRADUATION

4 YEAR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY

- SAT or ACT recommended to complete an application
- See individual websites for admissions requirements

2 YEAR COLLEGE

- No SAT or ACT required but recommended; open admission
- Transfer after meeting minimum university requirements using college GPA.
- Certificate/licensure programs

CAREER & TECHNICAL TRAINING

- Specific industry (automotive, culinary, dental assistant, etc.)
- Two Year Colleges offer Workforce Programs with technical training/licenses/certifications

MILITARY SERVICE

- Commit 4 to 6 years
- New GI Bill – full college tuition and living expenses
- Military Reserve Programs also assist with college cost
- Contact a recruiting office

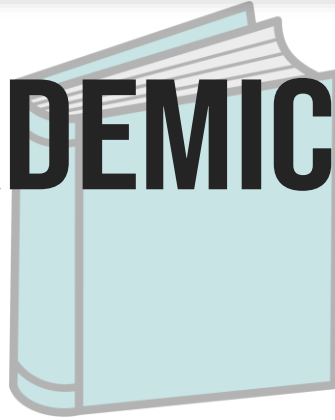

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

GPA is cumulative by semester

- ◇ Each year of high school is important
- ◇ High school credit earned in middle school is not calculated into the GPA (EXCEPTION-Courses taken on the high school campus and Art I taken for HS credit)
- ◇ All courses taken after the completion of middle school are averaged in the GPA except local credit courses (i.e. Office Assistant). Courses taken in the summer prior to 9th grade are calculated into the GPA

K, H, OR AP LEVEL CHANGES

- ◇ Parent communication with teacher via email, note, or phone call
- ◇ Student or parent may request a change at the Progress Report time and Report Card time of each grading period
- ◇ “F” average any grading period results in automatic removal
- ◇ “C-” average at semester results in automatic removal
- ◇ 5 points will not be awarded at the 2nd and 4th nine weeks marking period when dropping to on level

ADDITIONAL CREDIT OPTIONS

- ◇ CFISD Summer school
- ◇ Correspondence – Counselor permission required
- ◇ Houston Community College (night and summer school)
- ◇ Texas Virtual School
- ◇ Dual Credit – Lone Star College only
- ◇ Credit by Exam

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES

- ❑ State Law requires students to be in class 90% of the time in order to receive credit for the course
- ❑ Even with a passing grade for the semester, a student will not be awarded credit with Excessive Absences

- ◇ 3 years of attendance
- ◇ 17 credits

FRESHMAN SUCCESS

- ◇ Stay focused
- ◇ Have great attendance
- ◇ Attend tutorials
- ◇ Don't waste time
- ◇ Ask for help
- ◇ Stay organized
- ◇ Remember important dates & information
- ◇ Do not assume you have time to recover next year

PASS / FAIL

- ◇ Certain 3rd or 4th year courses in a defined sequence
- ◇ Limited to two credits total: 1 junior year and 1 senior year
- ◇ Students should have a 6.0 GPA, mostly A's on their transcript
- ◇ Numerical grade on Report Card, P or F on transcript
- ◇ Not included in GPA
- ◇ Does not count as credit toward graduation

Application must be completed each semester


