PACE

Personal, Academic, and Career Exploration

- Taken by *all* 9th graders
- .5 credit (one semester)



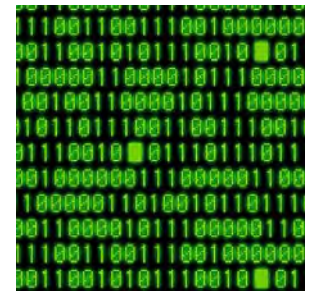
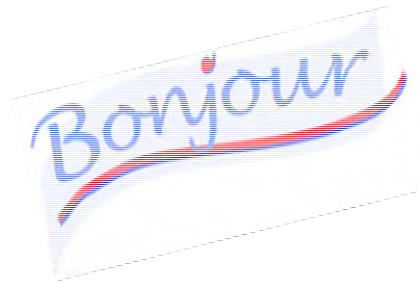
Health

- .5 credit required
- Can be paired with PACE
- *Principles of Health Science* (1.0) will *also* satisfy the Health requirement



LOTE/Foreign Language

- 2 credits of the same foreign language
 - Spanish
 - French
 - German
 - Latin
 - American Sign Language (*Cy-Ridge & Langham Creek only*)
 - Computer Science I K & Computer Science II AP A



Other Required Courses for Graduation

STEP 6: Select PACE, Health, & LOTE/Foreign Language courses for High School 4-Year Plan

- **PACE (.5 credit) – Personal, Academic, & Career Exploration** – builds skills to assist in the transition to high school as well as future transitions to career, college, adulthood, and independence.
 - **Required in 9th grade**
 - **Not available to take in Summer School**

- **Health** – Health or Principles of Health Science in 10th or 11th grade (*choose one*)
 - Health – (.5 credit)
(Can be paired with PACE)
 - OR**
 - Principles of Health Science in 10th or 11th grade
(Recommended for those choosing the Public Services/Health Science endorsement option)

- **LOTE/Foreign Language – 2 credits of the same language are required** (*choose one*)
(This includes any Foreign Language credits earned in middle school)
 - Spanish
 - French
 - German
 - Latin
 - American Sign Language (Cy-Ridge & Langham Creek only)
 - Computer Science I K & Computer Science II AP A

Be sure to list any credits you earned in middle school in the column on the left.

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Enter LOTE/Foreign Language Requirement in 4-Year Plan

● Add LOTE/Foreign Language

(this includes any credits earned in Middle School) and any additional years desired

- Spanish I, II, III (on-level or K), IV (K, AP), V (K, AP), VI (K)
- Spanish I (NS), II/III-K (NS), IV-AP (NS)
- French I, II, III-K, IV (K, AP), V (K), VI (K)
- German I, II, III-K, IV (K, AP), V (K), VI (K)
- Latin I, II, III-K, IV (K, AP), V (K)
- American Sign Language I, II, III K
- Computer Science I K, Computer Science II AP A



Check your work!

Make sure you have:

- 4 credits of English (and the level)
- 4 credits of Math (and the level)
- 4 credits of Science (and the level)
- At least 3 credits of Social Studies (and the level)
- .5 credit of PACE
- .5 credit of Health
(or a .5 credit elective with PACE instead of Health if taking Principles of Health Science in 10th or 11th grade)
- At least 2 credits of LOTE/Foreign Language
(including the credits earned in middle school)
