## Other Required Courses for Graduation

STEP 6: Select PACE, Health, \& LOTE/Foreign Language courses for High School 4-Year Plan
> PACE ( $\mathbf{5}$ credit) - $\underline{\text { Personal, }}$ Academic, \& Career Exploration - builds skills to assist in the transition to high school as well as future transitions to career, college, adulthood, and independence.

- Required in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade
- Not available to take in Summer School
> Health-Health or Principles of Health Science in $10^{\text {th }}$ or $11^{\text {th }}$ grade (choose one)
X Health - (. 5 credit)
(Can be paired with PACE)
