# 5 Endorsement Areas

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- **STEM** – Science, Technology (including computer science), Engineering, and advanced Math
- **Business & Industry** – Information Technology, database management, marketing, accounting, finance, graphic design, construction, welding, automotive technology, agriculture, hospitality & tourism (culinary arts)
- **Public Service** – Health Science occupations, education, human services (child guidance, cosmetology), JROTC
- **Arts and Humanities** – Political science, cultural studies, history, world languages, fine arts (Art, Dance, Music, & Theatre)
- **Multidisciplinary** – Provides students the opportunity to take a variety of courses from each of the other four endorsement areas.

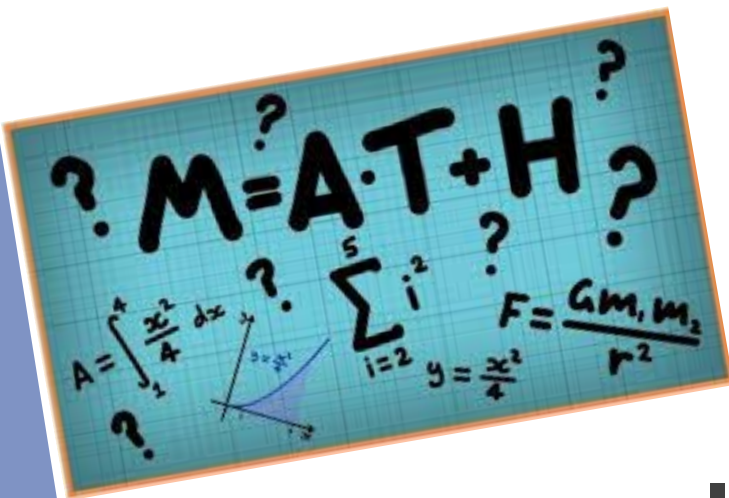

# Advanced Classes Eligibility for Entry into K-level Classes

## Language Arts, Science and Social Studies

- ❖ Students must have an 85 or higher end of the year average in that subject area or earn Masters Level on STAAR. Eligible students will be scheduled into that K-level class. Parents will be notified of the K-level placement and may opt their child out.

## Math

- ❖ Students must meet the above criteria and earn an 80+ in the appropriate summer program, or credit by exam.

\*\*K- Level classes move at a **faster pace** and **demand more out of class time** for assignments.

\*\*Students are expected to be independent and self-directed learners.

\*\*These classes are designed to challenge you beyond grade level.



# Physical Education



- **Regular Physical Education (PE)**
- **Athletics Girls— Cross Country, Volleyball, Basketball, Track**
- **Athletics Boys— Cross Country, Football, Basketball, Track**
- **Off-Campus PE— Apply online - deadline May 1<sup>st</sup>**
- **All Athletics---MUST have a Doctor's physical (forms online)**
- **Athletics is a full year commitment. Off season requires a lot of running.**

# Full Year Electives



- **Intermediate Theatre Arts** — must have been in Music-Theatre rotation or Theatre Arts 6 or teacher recommendation
- **Beginning Art**
- **Advanced Art** —must have been in sixth grade full year Art *and/or* teacher approval
- **Yearbook** —application may be picked up in the counseling office (Due: February 16<sup>th</sup>)

# High School Credits (Foreign Language)

- You need two years of the same foreign language to graduate
- You may choose to begin your foreign language in middle school and earn high school credit. (If you choose to take it in high school, it will count in your GPA.)



# Full Year Electives: Foreign Languages

## Spanish

- **Spanish I - Grade requirement**
  - Second semester average of 80+ in 6<sup>th</sup> grade on-level language arts or 75+ in K- level or Horizons language arts
- **Spanish Native Speaker I - Spanish language background (screening occurs in the spring)**

## French

- **French I – Grade requirement**
  - Second semester average of 80+ in 6<sup>th</sup> grade on-level language arts or 75+ in K-level or Horizons language arts.
