CHANGES IN TRANSPORTATION

End of Day Transportation Procedures

As always, our top priority is the safety and security of our students and staff. Please help us keep your children safe by adhering to our end of day procedures. These procedures are designed to get your children home each day safely and efficiently. One primary means of transportation should be chosen for the year. Changes of transportation should be kept to a minimum and must be in writing. Requirements are established to help guarantee the safety of every student. A change in transportation must be arranged prior to 2:30 pm to allow adequate time for our staff to communicate the change to the appropriate persons. When there is a change from the usual means of transportation, parents must notify the school in writing. All communication should be directed to the homeroom teacher. Written permission for a change in transportation may be faxed, if necessary.

Adam Morning Car Rider Line



Welcome to Adam. We are so glad you are here. Here are some tips for a smooth car rider drop off in the morning.

1. The car rider line will line up along Dakar, take a right onto Honey Grove Lane and then a right into the parking lot. Follow the arrows on the map above.
2. Students can begin being dropped off at 8:20. The car rider staff will move the line at that time.
3. When the car in front of you stops, your student will get out and go to the sidewalk to walk to the front door of the building.
4. Please have your student exit the passenger side of the vehicle for safety.
5. Please take a right when exiting the parking lot to ensure a safe flow of traffic.
6. If you are the first person in the line, please stop on Honey Grove Lane at the parking lot entrance. (a dot on the map above)
7. At 8:45, you will need to park and sign your student in at the front office. Please do not let your student out of the car if there is no staff in the parking lot.

Adam Afternoon Car Rider Line



Welcome to Adam. We are so glad you are here. Here are some tips for a smooth car rider dismissal.

1. The car rider line will line up along Dakar, take a right onto Honey Grove Lane and then a right into the parking lot. Follow the arrows on the map above.
2. If you are the first person in the line, please stop on Honey Grove Lane at the parking lot entrance. (a dot on the map above)
3. Please have your car rider number hanging from your front mirror. A staff member will record numbers as you pass them.
4. Remove your number when your student has loaded. This indicates to the staff that you don't need assistance.
5. The first person in each round will pull to the star. Follow the directions of the staff members on where to stop.
6. Please take a right when exiting the parking lot to ensure a safe flow of traffic.
7. We will begin loading cars about 4:12.
8. Students will be loaded on the passenger side of the car.
8. Please be in line by 4:25 to have your number recorded. If you are after that time, you will need to park and go in to sign your child out.
