OPTION 1 : Social Studies










Government and Public Administration Endorsement: Arts & Humanities






REQUIRED FOR ENDORSEMENT

Students may earn an Arts & Humanities endorsement by completing at least five (5) social studies credits.

Suggested social studies courses to take in addition to the three (3) required credits:

- *World Geography or Human Geography AP (if not taken as 1 of the 3 required credits)
- *World History or World History AP (if not taken as 1 of the 3 required credits)
- European History AP (1 credit)
- World Area Studies (1 credit)
- *Psychology or Psychology AP (1/2 credit)
- Sociology (1/2 credit)
- Street Law (1/2 1 credit)





Arts & Humanities Endorsement OPTION 2:

LOTE/Foreign Language

(4 levels of the same foreign language*)


OR

LOTE/Foreign Language Combo

(<u>2 levels in each of 2 different foreign</u> <u>languages for a total of 4 credits</u>*)

*Note: This includes the 2 credits of Foreign Language that are required for graduation





Arts & Humanities Endorsement OPTION 3:

Fine Arts

(<u>4 courses in the same fine arts area for 4 credits*</u>)

- Art (Visual Arts)
 (Drawing & Painting, Digital Art & Media, Ceramics/Sculpture, & Photography)
- Dance/Dance Team
- Music (Band or Band/Color Guard)
- Music (Choir)
- Music (Orchestra)
- Theatre

OR

Fine Arts Combo

(2 courses in each of 2 different fine arts areas for 4 total credits*)
