## Arts \& Humanities Endorsement

## Government and Public Administration

Endorsement: Arts \& Humanities


Students may earn an Arts \& Humanities endorsement by completing at least five (5) social studies credits.

Suggested social studies courses to take in addition to the three (3) required credits:

- *World Geography or Human Geography AP (if not taken as 1 of the 3 required credits)
- *World History or World History AP (if not taken as 1 of the 3 required credits)
- European History AP (1 credit)
- World Area Studies (1 credit)
- *Psychology or Psychology AP (1/2 credit)
- Sociology ( $1 / 2$ credit)
- Street Law (1/2-1 credit)

## LOTE/ Foreign Language

(4 levels of the same foreign language*)

(2 levels in each of 2 different foreign languages fora total of 4 credits*)
