## Option 1 - CTE

4 credits with at least 2 courses in the same career cluster with at least 1 advanced CTE course

## Option 2 - English

4 English elective credits
including 3 courses in one of the following:

- Journalism
(Newspaper/Yearbook)
- Debate


## Option 3 - Combination

- 4 credits from Options 1 and Option 2
- Must include 1 Advanced CTE course


## Business \& Industry Endorsement - Option 1-CTE

How will you know if the group of courses you selected will satisfy the endorsement requirement? Use the following checklist:
A. Will you earn 4 or more CTE credits from courses that fall within the same endorsement?
B. Are at least 2 of those courses from the same cluster?
C. Is at least 1 of the courses listed as "advanced"?
