Business and Industry Endorsement Options

Option 1 – CTE

4 credits with at least 2 courses in the same career cluster with at least 1 advanced CTE course

- Finance
- Hospitality & Tourism
- Information Technology

Option 2 – English

4 English elective credits including 3 courses in one of the following:

- Journalism (Newspaper/Yearbook)
- Debate

Option 3 – Combination

- 4 credits from Options 1 and Option 2
- Must include 1 Advanced
 CTE course



Business & Industry Endorsement – Option 1-CTE

How will you know if the group of courses you selected will satisfy the endorsement requirement? Use the following checklist:

- A. Will you earn 4 or more CTE credits from courses that fall within the same endorsement?
- B. Are at least 2 of those courses from the same cluster?
- C. Is at least 1 of the courses listed as "advanced"?

Here is an example:

Student 1 - Student is interested in learning to be a chef, but also wants to own and run a food truck.				
Intro to Culinary Arts (1 credit)	A-yes, all 4 credits are from the Business & Industry endorsement (1 from Business			
Culinary Arts (2 credits-advanced)	Mgmt cluster and 3 from Hospitality & Tourism cluster)			
Business Management (1 credit)	B-yes, Intro to Culinary Arts and Culinary Arts are both from same cluster C-yes, Culinary Arts			
Result: This combination of courses WILL SATISFY the CTE course credit requirement for an endorsement in Business & Industry.				





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
