#### **Who should attend the career fair?**

- We welcome applicants interested in *all* professional and support positions. This is an opportunity for those interested in employment with Cypress-Fairbanks ISD to meet and greet campus administrators and department leaders.

#### **What are some examples of employment opportunities?**

- We have career opportunities across all PreK-12 positions (elementary, middle and high school) as well as opportunities for teachers and paraprofessionals interested in supporting Bilingual, Special Education, and CTE students.
- We are also hiring bus drivers, nurses, school nutrition workers, custodians, Club Rewind staff, and many more!

#### **What are the requirements for certified teachers and aspiring teachers who would like to attend the Career Fair?**

- There are no specific requirements; however, you may bring a copy of your certification to share with campus administrators. ACP applicants are encouraged to bring their Statement of Eligibility (SOE).

#### **What are the requirements for other licensed professionals, degreed individuals, those with a high school diploma or GED, and individuals in non-certified trade positions to attend the career fair?**

- There are no specific requirements; all are welcome to attend.

#### **Do I need to register? Is there a fee?**

- For teaching and non-teaching positions, you are *encouraged* to pre-register (search in Job Listings) Career fair Pre-Registration - [Non-Teaching Positions](#) | [Teaching](#) No, there are no fees associated with this event.

#### **Can applicants who have received a CFISD contract offer attend the Career Fair?**

- Absolutely! Please check your emails regularly and come to meet the campus administrators on the day of the event.

#### **Can paraeducators interested in a teaching role attend the Career Fair?**

- Yes, paraeducators interested in a teaching position can attend and meet our campus administrators.

#### **What do I need to bring to the Career Fair?**

- Bring copies of your résumé to share with individual campuses/departments. **Copies will not be made at the event.**

#### **What campuses or departments will be represented?**

- All campuses and departments have been invited to attend the Career Fair, including 59 elementary, 20 middle, and 12 high schools, as well as 5 specialty campuses. Departments will include Operations, Transportation, Nutrition Services, Police Department and many more!

#### **Do I need an application on file to attend the Career Fair?**

- We *strongly encourage* all attendees to submit a completed application prior to the Career Fair. Visit [Career Opportunities](#) to see a list of all the available positions and submit your online application.

#### **Will Cypress-Fairbanks ISD be interviewing or hiring at the Career Fair?**

- This is a “Meet and Greet” event. Campus or department leaders may choose to interview or make recommendations for hire at a later date.

#### **Is there a dress code?**

- Professional dress is strongly encouraged.

#### **Should current Cypress-Fairbanks ISD employees attend the Career Fair?**

- The Career Fair is intended for external candidates who are interested in employment with Cypress-Fairbanks ISD.
- Current certified teachers and paraeducators should follow the district’s transfer process if interested in a lateral transfer.

#### **I have an undergraduate degree but am not certified. I am interested in learning more about how to become a teacher. Should I attend?**

- Yes! During the Career Fair, you will have the opportunity to meet with representatives from Alternative Certification Programs who can share information about this process. Our Human Resources staff members will also be there to answer your questions.

#### **Does CFISD pay teachers a competitive salary?**

- Yes! CFISD’s starting salary for new teachers for 2023-2024 is \$62,000 which ranks among the top starting salaries across Texas.

#### **What student loan opportunities are available for teachers?**

- Federal, state, and public service student-loan forgiveness programs are available for teachers and other educators.

#### **I have friends who are interested in non-teaching roles, but they do not speak English. Will there be Spanish-speaking staff who can assist them?**

- Yes. Our Human Resources department will have Spanish speaking staff ready to assist.
