

CFISD Project-Based Research in Web Development

Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

This course is a supervised research study project-based class where students will apply knowledge and skills from previous web technologies courses in a related advanced/specialized field of study. Students are required to submit a formal project plan within 15 school days after enrollment in the course. The plan should specify the additional concepts and/or technologies that will be studied and utilized, along with an overview of the culminating project. (1credit)

Grades 11 - 12

- Required prerequisite: Animation II or Web Technologies II
- Satisfies advanced course requirement for Business & Industry endorsement.
- Lab supplies or fee may be required.
