CFISD Practicum in Information Technology Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

This course allows students to apply and expand upon previously learned IT concepts and principles in the classroom and the workplace. In the classroom portion of the course, students will gain knowledge of professional standards as required by business and industry. Students will also receive industry-recognized training designed to make them more marketable and desirable in the workplace. Students are required to work 10 hours per week at an approved training site and must be employed at that site within 15 school days after enrollment in the course. (2 Credits)

- Required prerequisite: (or concurrent): At least 2 technology courses with at least one being Networking or Internetworking Tech I
- Students must provide own transportation to the work sit
- Lab supplies or fee may be required
