CFISD Cosmetology I

Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

This 2-hour block laboratory instructional sequence course continues the integration of academic, career, and technical knowledge and skills designed to provide job-specific training for employment in cosmetology careers. All the skills listed in the Introduction to Cosmetology course are continued for skill enhancement in this course. In addition, analysis of career opportunities, requirements, expectations, and development of workplace skills are included. Attendance is critical to the earning of the monitored 1000 clock hours required for qualification for taking the state examination for licensing. (2 credits)

- Required prerequisite (or concurrent): Introduction to Cosmetology
- An application may be required if demand exceeds number of available slots.
- Purchase of lab kit and uniform may be required, depending on what was purchased in Introduction to Cosmetology.
