November

Feedback Forms made available to all stakeholders via campus and district websites.

February

District Code of Conduct Committee meets to discuss and reach consensus on possible revisions to the Student Code of Conduct.

August

Final draft of Code of Conduct will be presented to the CFISD Board of Trustees for final approval

December

District Education Improvement Committee (DEIC) presentation and seek feedback regarding possible revisions to the Code of Conduct.

March-July

Provide assigned portions of the Student Code of Conduct/ Student Handbook to district level departments for review and suggested revisions.


Monitor 88th Texas Legislative Session to determine possible impact


