

Title: **American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers Scholarship**

Deadline: May 1, 2024

Award Amount: \$3,000

Program Description/History:

The ASHRAE awards four scholarships to graduating high school senior who have been accepted into an engineering, pre-engineering or engineering technology program. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 and should submit official transcript grades, a letter of admission and three signed letters of recommendation.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be high school seniors with a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0 on a scale where 4.0 is the highest and/or a class standing of no less than the top 30% and accepted into an engineering, pre-engineering, or engineering technology program at a post-secondary educational institution that meets at least one of the following criteria:

- the institution hosts a recognized ASHRAE student branch ASHRAE Student Branches
- the program is accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) www.abet.org or the Partnership for Air-Conditioning, Heating, Refrigeration Accreditation (PAHRA) http://pahrahvacr.org/Content/Schools_38.aspx
- the program is accredited by an agency outside the USA that is a signatory of The Washington Accord or The Sydney Accord
- the program is accredited by an agency that has a signed Memorandum of Understanding with ABET.
